The 'Old Cicestrians' are delighted to invite you to join us on Saturday 20th October 2018 at Chichester high school to celebrate 90 years since the foundation of Chichester high school for boys in 1928

The Old Cicestrians Association, with the generous support of the current Chichester High School, are organising a major celebration and reunion open to all former students, staff and their partners of CHSB and the Lancastrian School.

The packed programme for the day will begin with a fascinating **audio-visual presentation**, kindly narrated by David Wood OBE, Actor, Playwright, Author and former CHSB student. He will take you through the nine decades of the school's history tracing the many events and developments that made the school and its students so successful. This will be followed by:

The opportunity to view the extensive **array of past photographs, memorabilia** (and some video) celebrating the achievements of so many former students, school teams and the many extracurricular activities that made the school so popular and famous locally and nationally. Old Cicestrian Colin Snook will be displaying his recently created record of the fifty-four former students and staff who gave their lives in the Second World War.

Included in the ticket price are welcoming **morning refreshments** with hot and cold drinks, a very tasty **buffet lunch**; a cash bar will also be available for those Old Boys who wish to buy their former teachers a nice glass of wine! We anticipate this will be an ideal opportunity to make contact with old friends and put in your diary the date of the Old Cicestrians' Christmas Luncheon on Saturday 1st December 2018 at the Chichester Park Hotel. After lunch we have arranged **student guided tours of the school** and site to include such excellent attractions as the **Chichester Gymnastics building** (named after possibly our most famous Old Boy, **Tim Peake**) where youngsters will be displaying their amazing talents; the opportunity to see our nationally renowned **Combined Cadet Force in action** and then the great opportunity to visit the award winning **South Downs Planetarium** (that is on the school site!) where yet another Old Boy, Dr John Mason MBE will give a short talk about the importance of the Planetarium and the life of Astronaut Tim Peake.

The cost for the day is £25 per person, to include a Commemorative Booklet, buffet lunch, tea, coffee and cold drinks and South Downs Planetarium visit.
